## One Sheet Wonder (8-1/2"x11")

## Supply List (consumables listed are for 10 cards):

- Stamps: Artistic Impressions, Thank You Kindly
- Inks: Baja Breeze, Crumb Cake, Soft Suede, River Rock
- Card Stock: Very Vanilla (1sheet +1 for embellishments), Baja Breeze ( 3 sheets), River Rock (3 sheets)
- Envelopes: Medium Very Vanilla (10)
- Accessories: Stampin' Sponge ( $1 / 4$ is fine), Glue Sticks (1 per every 2 people) or other adhesive such as SNAIL.


## Measurements:

Cut the 3 sheets of Baja Breeze card stock, in half to $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Fold five of the six pieces in half for card bases. Do the same with the River Rock card stock. Keep remaining $1 / 2$ sheet of each color to cut down for card layers of contrasting colors on cards $3,4,8,9$, and 10 , and optional layer on card 7 for the greeting.

## Detailed Instructions:

1. Stamp one sheet of Very Vanilla (or Whisper White) with your design.
2. For my design, I first stamped the line flourish diagonally across the card stock in both directions, creating a pattern. I used Soft Suede ink and gently tapped off TWO times on scratch paper before stamping on the Very Vanilla card stock. (see picture below)

3. I then stamped the circle flourish in River Rock, the Eiffel Tower in Baja Breeze, the crown in Crumb Cake, and the key in Soft Suede ink at full strength. I also added in the word 'Amour' stamped off once in Baja Breeze, but you can leave that out if you think it makes it look too girly. (see picture below)

4. Tap a Stampin' Sponge in Soft Suede and pounce over areas on your sheet that look more bare than the rest, to fill in your sheet and add to the vintage look of the collage. (see picture below)

5. Cut the stamped Very Vanilla sheet according to One Sheet Wonder template, which you will find at the end of these instructions. You may find it handy to mark the corresponding number on the back of each piece, to keep track.(Optional: sponge around the edges of each piece with Soft Suede ink to give it a great finished look.)
6. Cut $1 / 4$ " from each straight side of pieces $1 \& 2$ so they layer well on a card front.
7. Assemble ten cards according each of the ten layouts shown on the One Sheet Wonder template.
