

Onesie/Gown/Dress Pattern

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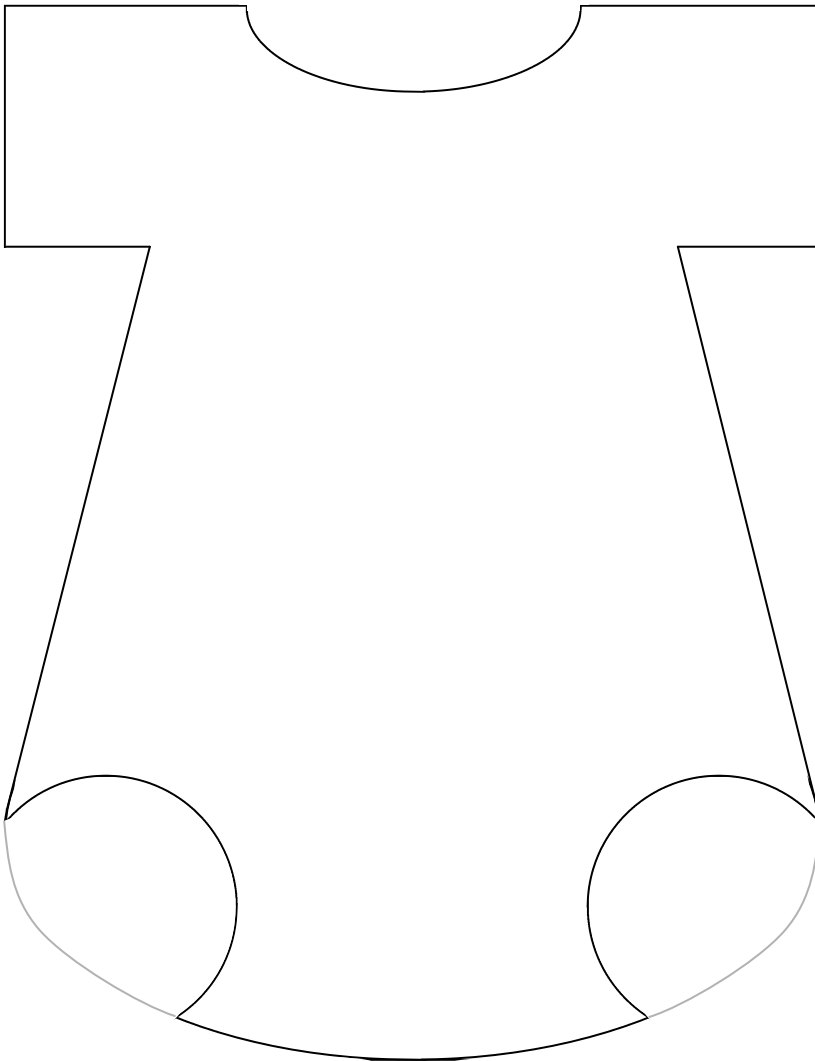
QUICK START NOTES

To make a card:

Cut card stock to 4-1/4" by 11", then score in half to make 4-1/4" by 5-1/2" card base. Print and cut out this pattern to use as a template, punching out the neck with the Large Oval Punch, and the leg holes with the 1-3/8" Circle Punch. Line up the fold of the card stock card base with the top line of the printed and trimmed pattern, and trace around the template lightly with pencil. Trim sleeves and sides, and punch neck and legs, and erase any remaining pencil lines with a vinyl eraser. (TIP: fold template in half to get a center line, and punch one 1/16" hole in folded template, near the bottom, centered between the fold line and the leg opening. Then unfold template and there will be two holes to use for marking placement of brads or eyelets.)

To make embellishments:

Reduce the pattern to the size you want, then cut out and use as a template to create smaller onesies, gowns, or even angel bodies.



- This pattern can be used to make a onesie, when circles are punched out at the bottom for leg holes, or it can be used to make a gown or dress. Print out two patterns to trim differently--punch the legs out on one template, and on the second template, leave the leg holes intact by trimming around the rounded bottom for a gown template.
- To punch the neck opening, use a Large Oval Punch. A scallop trim may be applied around the opening by layering card stock punched with the Oval Scallop Punch.
- To punch the leg holes, use the 1-3/8" Circle Punch. A scallop trim may be applied around the leg holes by layering card stock punched with the Scallop Circle Punch.
- Scallops may be applied to the ends of the sleeves by layering card stock punched with the Square Scallop Punch. (Note: you will first need to trim at least 1/16" from the end of each sleeve to keep the finished card narrow enough to fit into your envelope!)
- Use brads or eyelets at the bottom for faux "snaps".
- The Ovals Sizzix Die and the Oval Scallop Frame Sizzix Die are great companion shapes to use for adding a "bib", a onesie bottom flap, and/or ruffles.
