

Matchbook Mini-Album Folding Pages (using one 12x12 sheet)

READ ALL DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY THROUGH FIRST!

If you use card stock, you can stamp the side that's facing up, if you'd like to have a pattern on your pages. If you use one-sided Designer Paper, make your score marks with the patterned side facing up. If you use double-sided Designer Paper, make your score marks with your chosen patterned side facing up.

RED = Cut Along This Line BLUE = Fold Along This Line

Score all lines first, then go back and cut along the score lines where indicated in red. For best results in getting facing pages to measure up correctly, I recommend finding the vertical center of the page first, and making your score line from top to bottom. Then, find the horizontal center of the page, and make your score line from right to left. Make the rest of your measurements outwards from the center score lines. Exactness and accuracy in measurement is very important.

The two 6" sections which come together back to back with a mountain fold will need to be adhered together to form a page. Each of the rest of the pieces of the same size will also be adhered back to back. The back of the first 6" page will be adhered inside your matchbook cover.
